*These Championships will be conducted as per CSD National Rulebook 2004, No.1.  
All matches are from the rulebook, unless stated otherwise.*

### **General Information:**

You will need to bring the following:

- Valid Grading Card, No Grade Card = automatic Grand Master grade.
- Firearms Licence (carry it at all times), you WILL be asked to produce it!
- Eye, Ear & Foot protection, shooting mat, etc.
- NO OPTICAL EQUIPMENT allowed at the firing line at any time. (ie. Spotting scope, Binoculars, etc.)
- Same ammunition type & loading to be used throughout an event. Ammunition may be sampled at any time during the competition, allow six (6) rounds extra per event for power factor compliance testing.
- It is up to the **competitor** to check that their score sheet is filled in correctly by the scorer at the targets, regarding Class of rifle, score & grade.
- This is a championship competition, there will NOT be any fouling shots or sighting in on the day of competition.

For Pistol – Class 1 & Class 2 “as issued” pistols.  
For Rifle – .310 Cadet &/or .22 Training rifle for Friday event.  
Class A/B/C “as issued” rifle, for core events.  
Class H for Modified/Accurised events.  
Class F1, F2 & T/J for long range events.

*Notes: Scrutineering 0800, Sign-on 0830, Briefing 0900, Competition starts 0930.*

*Events 1, 2, 3 & 4 make up the Pistol Championships.*

*Pistol classes 1 & 2. - Class 1 must be shot First, then Class 2.*

*Shoot Events 1 to 4 - Class 1, then events 1 to 4 – Class 2.*

Event 1 – Match 9 - 50m Long Range	(12 rounds)
Event 2 – Match 2 - 25m 3 Position	(18 rounds)
Event 3 – Match 7 – Standing Rapid Fire 25m	(6 rounds)
Event 4 – Match 1 – 3P Core Event	(36 rounds)

**Once Pistol Matches are completed & target frames moved.**

*Cadet & Training rifles will both shoot and compete together, scored separately. Open event.*

*All targets will be Target 6 - Mini Core (600x600mm)*

*It is up to the **competitor** to check that their score sheet is filled in correctly by the scorer at the targets, regarding Class of rifle, score & grade.*

### **Standard Rifle.**

*Each detail will complete Events 6, 7, & 8 shot back to back. Need 60 rounds on the line.*

*All targets will be Target 1 - Core target.*

*Class A/B/C “as issued” competitors are to use the same standard rifle for ALL events.*

Event 6	- Match 9 – 300m Deliberate	(10 rounds)
Event 7	- Match 1 - 3P Core Event (300m walk-up)	(30 rounds)
Event 8	- Match 4 - Rapid Fire B (100m)	(20 rounds)

### **Modified/Accurised Rifle.**

*Each detail will complete Events 9, 10, & 11 shot back to back. Need 60 rounds on the line.*

*Class H “Mod/Acc” rifles only, using the same mod/acc rifle for ALL events, must not be the same rifle as used in Class A/B/C.*

Event 9	- Match 9 – 300m Deliberate	(10 rounds)
Event 10	- Match 1 - 3P Core Event (300m walk-up)	(30 rounds)
Event 11	- Match 4 - Rapid Fire B (100m)	(20 rounds)
